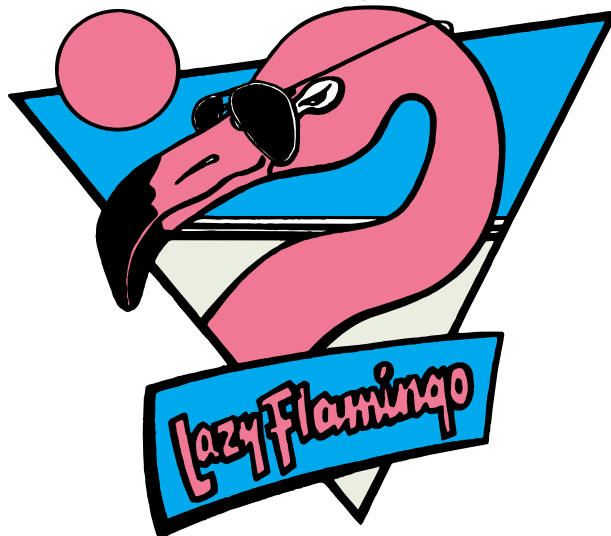

## LEGACY OF THE LINDBERGHs

Charles and Anne Morrow Lindbergh's achievements will be the focus of a symposium to honor the 75th anniversary of Charles Lindbergh's transatlantic flight and mark his 100th birthday. "Earth Shine: The Shared Vision, The Shared Legacy of Charles A. and Anne Morrow Lindbergh" will be Nov. 15 at Florida Gulf Coast University.

Anne Morrow Lindbergh penned her famous *Gift From the Sea* on Captiva and the Lindberghs frequently visited "Uncommon Friends" Jim and Ellie Newton at Ft. Myers Beach.

Speakers will include Sergei Sikorsky, a pioneer in helicopter search and rescue and son of Igor Sikorsky, former astronaut Rusty Schweickart of the Apollo 9 flight and Michael Collins of the Gemini 10 and Apollo 11 missions, photographer and writer John Nance, and atmosphere expert Dr. Robert M. White. They will address the Lindberghs' accomplishments and "their vision of a balance between technological advancement and environmental preservation."

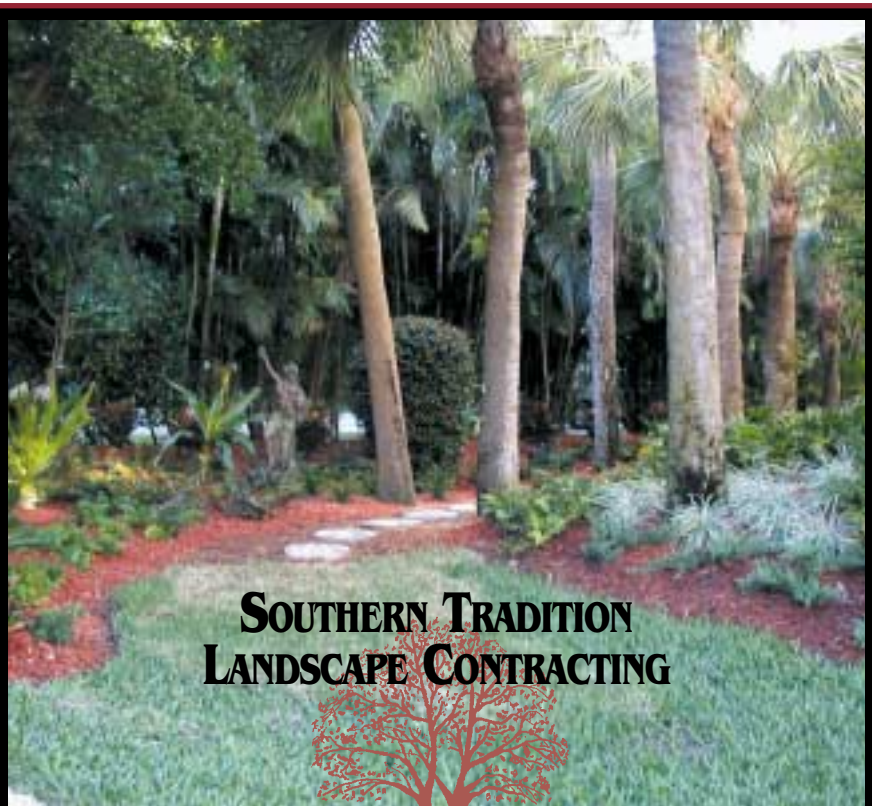

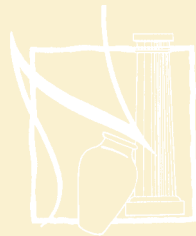
